Dark web, crypto, drones are major challenges, says Shah

Seized drugs worth ₹16,914 crore in 2024

New Delhi, January 11

UNION HOME MINISTER Amit Shah said on Saturday that dark web, cryptocurrency, online marketplace and drones continue to be a challenge for the country and these have to be checked by strict measures.

Chairing a regional conference on 'Drug Trafficking and National Security' here, Shah also asserted that the country will not allow even a single kg of drugs to be smuggled in or out of the country. He said the government has not only been successful in eliminating many networks of drugs, but the terrorism linked with them too was also destroyed. He said many cases of narco-terrorism were busted in Jammu and Kashmir, Punjab, Gujarat and Uttar Pradesh and these were major achievements.

"The use of dark web, cryptocurrency, online marketplace, drones continue to be a challenge for us even today," he said. Shah said a technical solution to these problems have to be found through joint efforts by the states and the central government and technocrats for the country's security and development. He said the fight against drugs has gained a new strength under Prime Minister Narendra Modi's leadership. "In the last 10 years, there has been a seven-fold increase in the seizure of drugs which is a major achievement. The Modi government has given a strong message of destroying the entire ecosystem of drugs through strict action," he said.

The home minister said that in 2024, by seizing drugs worth ₹16,914 crore, the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) and police across the country took the biggest action against drugs, which is a significant

step in making a drug-free society. "No country can move forward on the path of development with a young generation suffering from drug addiction. It is our responsibility that we all fight this challenge together and make all efforts to win this battle," he said.

Shah said during 2014-24, altogether 24 lakh kg of drugs were seized—a seven-fold increase as compared to the previous decade. He said drugs worth ₹8,150 crore were disposed off in 2004-14 but in 2014-24, drugs worth ₹54,851 crore were destroyed, eight times more than the previous decade.

The conference, organised by the NCB, aims to address the growing concern of drug trafficking and its impact on national security, with a special focus on eight states and Union Territories of northern India.

Shah also launched the drug disposal fortnight start-

ing from Saturday to January 25. He said that during this period, one lakh kg of narcotics worth ₹8,600 crore will be destroyed.

The home minister also inaugurated the new office complex of the NCB's Bhopal zonal unit and extension of the MANAS-2 helpline to all 36 states and UTs.

The main focus of the conference is on the sharing of real-time information from the National Narcotics Helpline 'MANAS' portal with the Anti-Narcotics Task Force (ANTF) of states and UTs, evaluating the progress of states in combating drug trafficking, and assessing the effectiveness of the Narcotics Coordination Mechanism (NCORD).

Other issues to be discussed at the conference include strengthening and enhancing the functionality of State Forensic Science Laboratories (SFSLS), utilising the NIDAAN database to bolster

efforts against drug trafficking, implementing provisions of the Prevention of Illicit Traffic in Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (PIT-NDPS) Act, establishing special NDPS courts for the speedy trial of drug-related cases, and fostering a Whole-of-Government approach to ensure comprehensive collaboration among all agencies to combat drug trafficking and abuse effectively. Under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, the Government of India has adopted a zero tolerance policy against drug trafficking, an official release said.

The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) is implementing a three-pronged strategy to achieve a drug-free India by 2047. This includes strengthening institutional frameworks, enhancing coordination among narcotics agencies, and launching a public awareness campaign.

The conference is being attended by governors, lieutenant governors, chief ministers and senior officers from the eight participating states and UTs.

KANNAUJ RAILWAY STATION MISHAP

Under-construction building collapses, UP govt orders probe

Kannauj/ Uttar Pradesh, January 11

AN UNDER-CONSTRUCTION BUILDING at the Kannauj railway station collapsed on Saturday afternoon, trapping around two dozen workers under the rubble, officials said. Uttar Pradesh minister Rajni Tiwari has said that 24 people have been injured and those guilty of negligence will be punished after a probe. Six of the injured were pulled out of the debris and rushed to hospital.

The North Eastern Railway (NER) said it has constituted a three-member committee to probe the incident. Initial visuals from the site showed scenes of chaos and confusion with crowds,

clouds of dust and broken beams as people tried to rescue those who had been trapped.

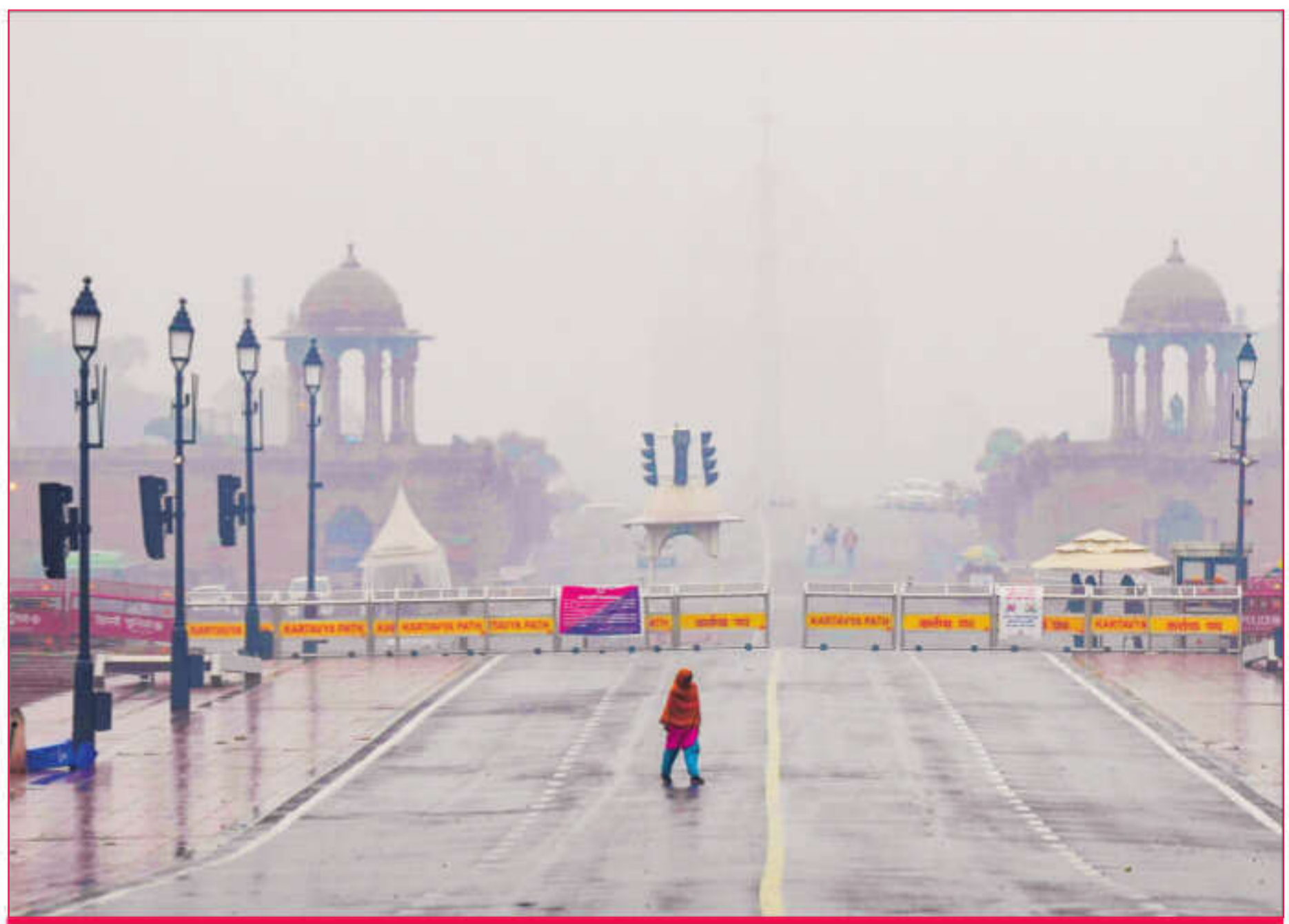
"According to preliminary information, the incident occurred when the under-construction shuttering of the roof collapsed," said District Magistrate (DM) Shubhant Kumar Shukl. "Our first priority is to rescue the workers who are trapped. We are using all resources at our disposal for the rescue efforts," Shukl, who had rushed to the spot along with other senior officials to supervise the rescue operation, added. Roof shuttering is a temporary structure that supports concrete while it sets.

Minister of State (Independent Charge), Social Welfare, Asim Arun also reached the spot.

Tata packs a Punch to end Maruti's 40-year reign

THIS CONTRASTS WITH 2023, where the list included one van (Eeco) in place of Scorpio. The dominance of SUVs in 2024 reflects buyers' growing appetite for vehicles that offer higher ground clearance, a commanding road presence, and versatile utility.

The domestic passenger vehicle market has undergone a dramatic transformation over the decades. From 1957 to 1984, Hindustan Motors' Ambassador was the top-selling car, cemented by government and public sector orders. Maruti Suzuki's journey to dominance began in 1985 with the Maruti 800, which dethroned the Ambassador. The company retained the top position with various models like the Alto (2005-2017),

Dzire (2018), Swift (2020 and 2023), and Wagon R (2021-2022).

Punch's achievement in 2024 signals a new era where competition among manufacturers is intensifying, fuelled by innovation and evolving consumer preferences. Despite its strong showing, Punch's sales numbers were not the highest in recent years.

Maruti Suzuki's Swift sold 203,469 units in 2023, while Wagon R reached 217,317 units in 2022.

The all-time record still belongs to Alto, which sold 311,367 units in 2011.

In 2024, however, Alto sold just 105,922 units, reflecting a broader trend where buyers are moving away from entry-level cars that lack advanced features and comfort. With a lead of over 11,000 units over Wagon R, Punch is well-positioned to maintain its dominance in FY25, potentially becoming the first non-Maruti Suzuki car in four decades to lead financial year sales.

Green Maha Kumbh a departure from the past

Post the fair, a report by the Comptroller and Auditor General had found there was inadequate handling of waste and pollution management—no additional infrastructure was built and no effective monitoring mechanisms were put in place that led to the city and river being severely polluted.

The Kumbh Mela in 2019 was hardly better in terms of waste management. The religious gathering generated 18,000 metric tonne of solid waste, which was transported to the Baswar Sewage Management Plant, a few kilometres away from the city. However, the plant had been non-functional since 2018 and was unable to process any of the waste.

The National Green Tribunal (NGT), at the time, chided the state government saying this was "the grossest violation of the orders of NGT and Solid Waste Management rules, 2016. The solid waste is lying in open, untreated and uncovered."

This time, though, things are looking different. Chaturvedi said, "We have done lots of community participation work, including workshops with school children to sensitise them regarding the non-use of plastic. We've also deployed safai karamcharis and people for hand picking garbage. Dustbins with liner bags are also kept in ample quantities."

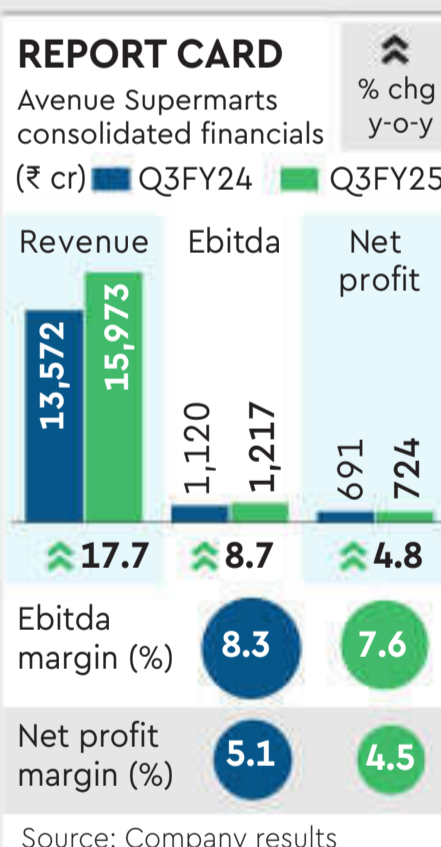
Masood Mallick, managing director and CEO of Re Sustainability, a sustainability solutions provider headquartered in Hyderabad, while applauding the initiatives, suggests that "making the Maha Kumbh a zero-carbon event by way of sponsored carbon offset projects could help significantly."

DMart Q3 net up 5%; revenue up 17%

AVENUE SUPERMARTS, WHICH runs the retail chain DMart, on Saturday, reported a 4.8% year-on-year increase in consolidated net profit to ₹724 crore for the December 2024 quarter (Q3FY25). It reported a net profit of ₹660 crore in the corresponding period last year.

The retailer saw consolidated revenue grow 17.7% to ₹15,973 crore versus ₹13,572 crore reported last year. Earnings before interest tax depreciation and amortisation (Ebitda) grew 8.7% year-on-year to ₹1,217 crore. Ebitda margin stood at 7.6% in Q3FY25 versus 8.3% reported in the same period last year. PAT margin also decreased to 4.5% versus 5.1% reported last year. Avenue Supermarts CEO and managing director Neville Noronha said, "The Q3 FY 2025 same-store revenue growth for 2 years and older stores was at 8.3%. However, we continue to see increased intensity in discounting in the FMCG category and the consequent impact to high turnover



per square feet stores in metro towns." On its online ordering service DMart Ready, Noronha said it grew by 21.5% in the first nine months of FY25. "In the rapidly evolving dynamics of the grocery e-commerce market, we are seeing significantly more demand for home delivery compared to the pick-up point, and hence, we con-

tinue to align our business to that extent," he added. Avenue Supermarts' total expenses in the December quarter rose to ₹15,001.64 crore from ₹12,656.46 crore in the same period last year.

As of December 31, 2024, the company had 387 operating stores with a retail business area of 16.1 million sq ft.

Seized drugs worth ₹16,914 crore in 2024

PRESS TRUST OF INDIA New Delhi, January 11

UNION HOME MINISTER Amit Shah said on Saturday that dark web, cryptocurrency, online marketplace and drones continue to be a challenge for the country and these have to be checked by strict measures.

Chairing a regional conference on 'Drug Trafficking and National Security' here, Shah also asserted that the country will not allow even a single kg of drugs to be smuggled in or out of the country. He said the government has not only been successful in eliminating many networks of drugs, but the terrorism linked with them too was also destroyed. He said many cases of narco-terrorism were busted in Jammu and Kashmir, Punjab, Gujarat and Uttar Pradesh and these were major achievements.

"The use of dark web, cryptocurrency, online marketplace, drones continue to be a challenge for us even today," he said. Shah said a technical solution to these problems have to be found through joint efforts by the states and the central government and technocrats for the country's security and development. He said the fight against drugs has gained a new strength under Prime Minister Narendra Modi's leadership.

"In the last 10 years, there has been a seven-fold increase in the seizure of drugs which is a major achievement. The Modi government has given a strong message of destroying the entire ecosystem of drugs through strict action," he said.

The home minister said that in 2024, by seizing drugs worth ₹16,914 crore, the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) and police across the country took the biggest action against drugs, which is a significant

The conference, organised by the NCB, aims to address the growing concern of drug trafficking and its impact on national security, with a special focus on eight states and Union Territories of northern India.

Shah also launched the drug disposal fortnight start-

ing from Saturday to January 25. He said that during this period, one lakh kg of narcotics worth ₹8,600 crore will be destroyed.

The home minister also inaugurated the new office complex of the NCB's Bhopal zonal unit and extension of the MANAS-2 helpline to all 36 states and UTs.

The main focus of the conference is on the sharing of real-time information from the National Narcotics Helpline 'MANAS' portal with the Anti-Narcotics Task Force (ANTF) of states and UTs, evaluating the progress of states in combating drug trafficking, and assessing the effectiveness of the Narcotics Coordination Mechanism (NCORD).

Other issues to be discussed at the conference include strengthening and enhancing the functionality of State Forensic Science Laboratories (SFSLS), utilising the NIDAAN database to bolster

KANNAUJ RAILWAY STATION MISHAP

Under-construction building collapses, UP govt orders probe

AN UNDER-CONSTRUCTION BUILDING at the Kannauj railway station collapsed on Saturday afternoon, trapping around two dozen workers under the rubble, officials said. Uttar Pradesh minister Rajni Tiwari has said that 24 people have been injured and those guilty of negligence will be punished after a probe. Six of the injured were pulled out of the debris and rushed to hospital.

The North Eastern Railway (NER) said it has constituted a three-member committee to probe the incident. Initial visuals from the site showed scenes of chaos and confusion with crowds,

clouds of dust and broken beams as people tried to rescue those who had been trapped.

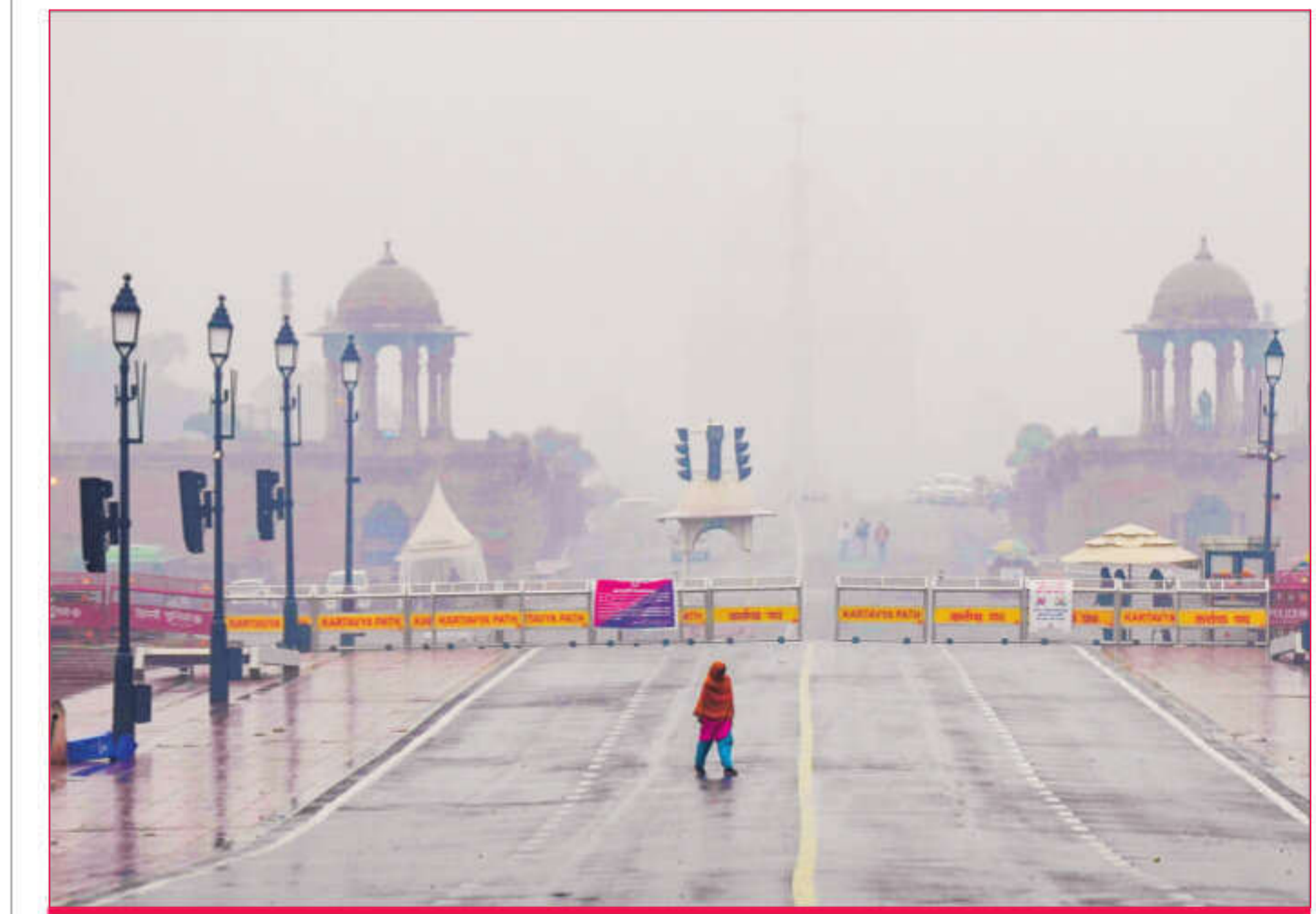
"According to preliminary information, the incident occurred when the under-construction shuttering of the roof collapsed," said District Magistrate (DM) Shubhant Kumar Shukl. "Our first priority is to rescue the workers who are trapped. We are using all resources at our disposal for the rescue efforts," Shukl, who had rushed to the spot along with other senior officials to supervise the rescue operation, added. Roof shuttering is a temporary structure that supports concrete while it sets.

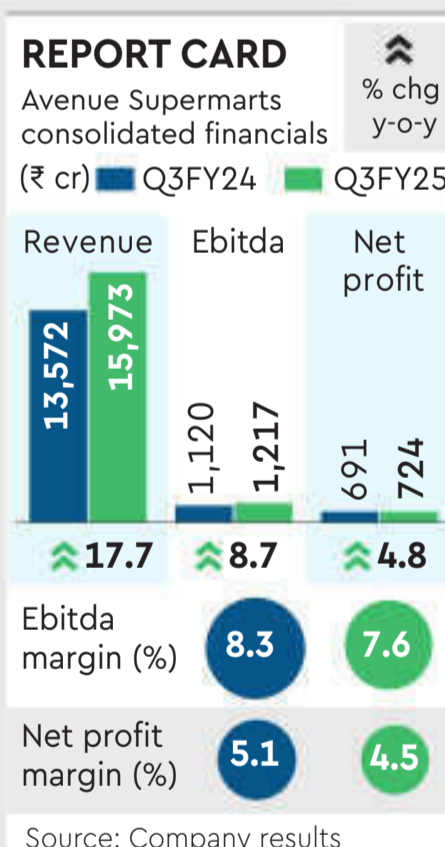
